Library Catalogue

The Library's catalogue is available online.

Contact the Library if you are unable to find an item in the catalogue.

We may be able to purchase it, obtain it from neighbouring libraries or request an inter-library loan.

Loans Service

Fellows living/working in the UK or Republic of Ireland may borrow from the Library, either when visiting the Library, or by post.

Fellows may borrow up to 6 books/journals and 6 maps.

Candidate/Junior Fellows may borrow up to 3 books/journals and 3 maps.

The loan period is four weeks after which an item may be renewed if not required by another reader.

Photocopying Service

A photocopier is available for use by those visiting the Library, or photocopies can be made by staff and posted to members worldwide.

Inter-Library Loans

Items not held by the Library may be obtained via our inter-library loan service. Copies of papers can be supplied electronically by the British Library via their Secure Electronic Delivery system.

Electronic Resources

Fellows can access over 100 e-journals and 20 e-books remotely by registering for Athens Access passwords.

The Society's own journals can be accessed online from your own PC and within the Library via the Lyell Collection.

A list of e-journals (many being open-access) is maintained on the website.

Literature Searches

The Library subscribes to several databases including GeoRef and Geofacets, which can be used when visiting the Library.

Staff can undertake searches on behalf of Fellows with results e-mailed or posted.

Study and meeting space

The Library offers comfortable study space in the heart of London, with public access PCs, areas for laptops and WiFi available. The Fellows' Room is an ideal space for informal meetings.
