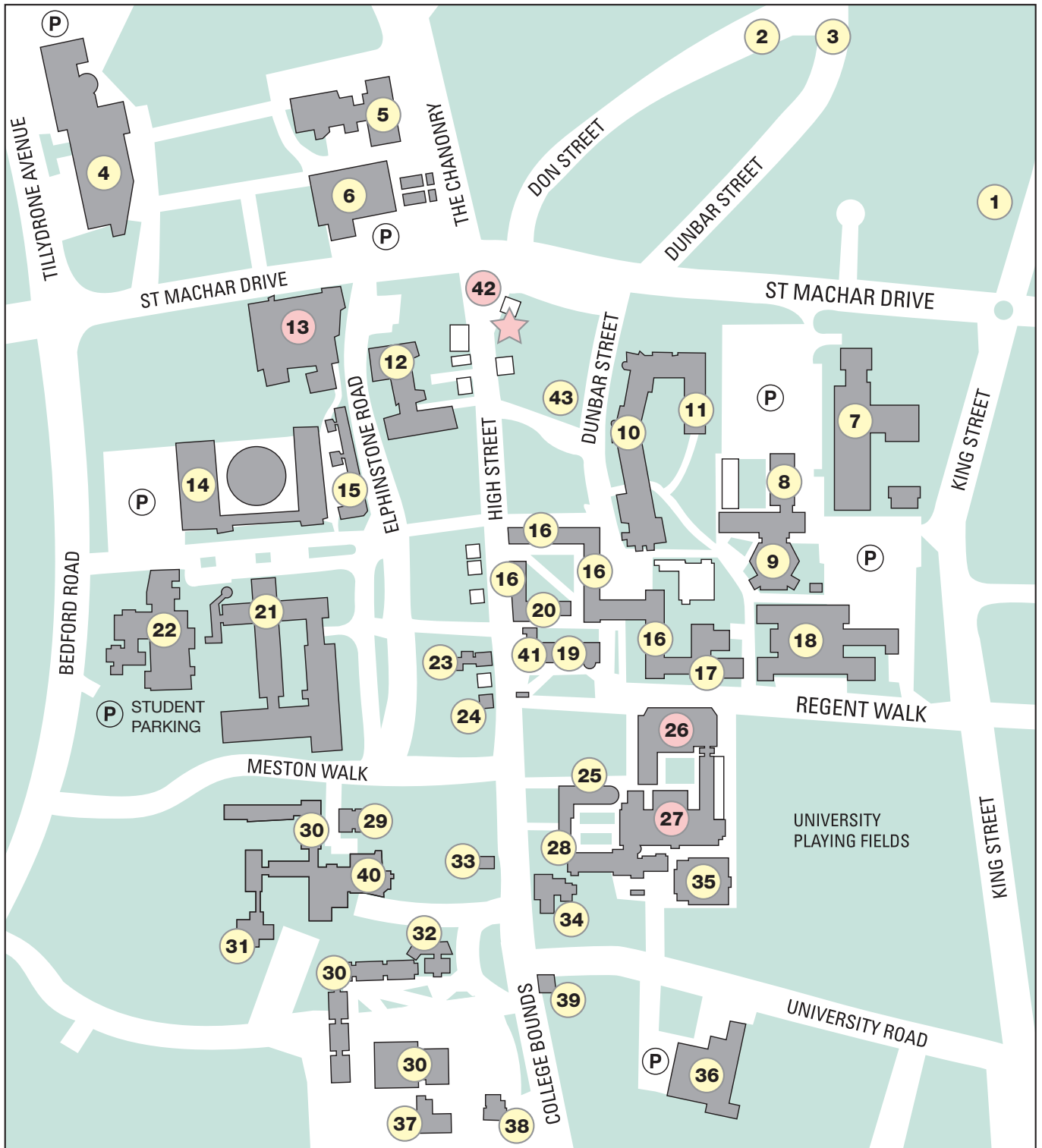


LOCATION MAP

DIRECTIONS

The University of Aberdeen is located at the heart of a diverse and thriving regional economy. Aberdeen's pivotal role in the international oil industry means that it enjoys excellent communication and travel links.

By Car

Entering the city from the south or west, follow signs to the A90 (Fraserburgh and Peterhead). This leads round the ring road (Anderson Drive). Exiting from a roundabout onto Cairncry Road, continue to follow the A90 signs through two further roundabouts onto St Machar Drive. After a third roundabout, the road bisects Old Aberdeen and local signs will direct you to the University. From the north, Old Aberdeen is signposted on the A96 (from Dyce and Inverness) and on the A90 (from Peterhead).

By Air

Aberdeen's international airport is served by a number of major carriers, providing an extensive network of routes throughout the UK, direct to Europe and worldwide through major hubs. British destinations include all London airports, Manchester, Southampton, Newcastle, Glasgow, Dublin, Belfast, Cardiff and other major English cities, as well as the Scottish Highlands and Islands. Continental destinations include Paris, Amsterdam, Copenhagen, Stavanger, Bergen, Esbjerg and the Faroe Islands.

Buses link directly from the airport to the city centre. Taxis from the airport to the University cost around £12-£14.

By Coach

First class roads south to Edinburgh, Glasgow and north to Inverness, carry fast coach services linking Aberdeen to the UK's major cities.

By Train

Rail services connect Aberdeen both north and south. There are regular direct trains to London and services from Edinburgh and Glasgow link with other mainline routes. Inverness, the scenic West Coast and Highlands, are reached northwards. Taxis from the railway station cost around £6-£8.

By Local Bus

Bus information is available by telephoning First, the main local operator, on +44 (0)1224-650065 or by visiting their website at www.firstgroup.com/ukbus/scotland/nescot/home/ Aberdeen buses require the exact fare, so have some change ready or buy a Farecard (available from local shops).

The First in Aberdeen Metro "Red Line" services 1 ("Danestone") and 2/2A ("Ashwood") operate to a combined 5 minute frequency during the daytime and a combined 15 minute frequency evenings and Sundays - on return to City, these buses show 1/1A ("Garthdee") or 2/2A ("Auchinyell"). Other services that pass the main university entrance on King Street are 15 ("Dubford") which run only during the daytime Monday-Saturday to a 30 minute frequency - on return to City, these buses show 15 ("Kingswells" or "Woodend"). There are other services (starting from Broad Street) which serve other parts of the campus - First in Aberdeen Metro Indigo Line 20 ("Hillhead") travels along College Bounds and First in Aberdeen Metro Turquoise Line 19 ("Tillydrone") travels via Bedford Road, both every 15 minutes during the daytime Monday-Saturday and every 30 minutes at other times.
