Poster Guidelines

The poster boards that will be in use at the society will be free standing **6ft (1830mm) tall x 3ft 1" (940mm) wide portrait** boards which will be able to accommodate A0 portrait posters easily.

Due to the large number of posters being displayed in the two sessions at the conference each board will be numbered and poster presenters will be provided with a board number prior to the conference. The numbers will be noted next to the posters in the conference abstract book to help delegates to find specific posters.

If you are presenting a poster in the first session at the conference please try to arrive at the society **at least 15 minutes before the start of the talks**. The poster session will be taking place in the Lower Library at Burlington House. Each poster board will be numbered and there will be a number of Velcro spots on each board which you can use to put up your poster. Your posters will remain up during the tea and coffee breaks and during lunch on the first day of the conference. Please feel free to spend time answering questions about your poster at these times.

If you are presenting your poster in the second poster session please bring your poster to the registration desk before the end of lunch on the second day and let the GSL representatives at the desk know the name of your poster and **the number that you have been given in the second session** and your posters will be put up before the afternoon coffee break.

First Session posters will be held at the registration desk from the afternoon coffee break on day 2 and session 2 posters will need to be taken down and collected at the end of the final day of the conference.
