

Groundwater Source Protection Zones – Delineation, Policy, Use

Directions to Venue

The meeting venue is in the Senior **Common Room Building**, which is in Chancellor's Courtyard adjacent to the Earth and Environment Building in the centre of the Leeds University Campus.

From the University main entrance (at "Parkinson Steps"):

Enter the campus through the arches of the link building (between buildings 1 and 4 on the campus map) continue along and take the first left (opposite the Great Hall, Building 2). Follow this past the Edward Boyle Library (Building 8) and down the flights of steps. At the base of the steps you are in the northeast corner of Chancellor's Courtyard and the Senior Common Room Building (Building 16) is on the west side. The simplest way in is to walk diagonally across the courtyard to the southwest corner and take the external steps up the side of the Senior Common Room Building. The venue is up two flights of steps (perversely, this is "Level 9"). The route above will be signposted on the day.

From the Free City Bus stop either:

1) enter the Worsley Building and go up to Level 10 – on this level there is a corridor network linking the campus buildings – follow this through the Roger Stevens building, then turn left, near the end of the corridor there is a door to the left out on to the external steps - go down one flight; or

2) navigate a more direct (but not entirely straightforward) route around the outside of the various buildings.
