Library Review (Update) – Following discussions during the November 2010 Council meeting, plans have been developed to implement the Review Group's recommendations. Council has now agreed a policy for journal cancellations and the Chief Librarian, working with the Library Advisory Committee, will identify journals for cancellation and report back to Council. Some library holdings (mostly duplicate stock and some material clearly outside the scope of the library) will be disposed of.
