A Geological Background for Applied Geology in Gloucestershire

This field day is being run by Dr Nick Chidlaw, a geologist with a background in teaching, research and industrial consulting.

It is designed to be of interest to Society members working in a variety of professions including ground engineering, petroleum geology, hydrogeology and education.

We shall visit two locations: Robinswood Hill, near Gloucester and Cleeve Hill, near Cheltenham. Members will be shown exposures in contrasting strata of a post-Carboniferous rift basin, together with landforms and road stabilization on the landslide-prone Cotswold Scarp.
