To apply for Junior Candidate Fellowship you must be age 16 or over and

• undergoing secondary education and able to provide satisfactory evidence of their intent to take a degree in geology or a related subject (see above)

You can remain a Junior Candidate Fellow until the age of 19, however you must apply for full Candidate Fellowship upon registering for an undergraduate honours degree in geology or a related subject (natural science, mathematics or engineering).
