Theme - Process-based classification: We will expand on one of the conference themes, actively process classifying cores and discussing potential impacts on reservoir description studies. We will specifically make use of cores from 4 diverse reservoirs:

- 1) Cretaceous (Barremian) Zubair Formation, Rumaila field, Iraq
- 2) Jurassic Brent Group, North Sea
- 3) Carboniferous Breagh Yoredale core, Southern North Sea
- 4) Pliocene Productive Series, ACG field, Azerbaijan

There will also be dedicated poster sessions on further core-based studies.

09.00-16.00 - Day 2 Core Workshop

Theme – Paralic reservoir characterisation: Using the same cores from day 1 we will expand on another of the conference themes, shifting focus to examine the importance of layering and heterogeneity at a variety of scales on paralic reservoir behaviour. We will integrate our core-based observations with dynamic data to better understand the geometry, extent and connectivity of different sandbody types and intervening shales. We will also consider what level of detail is appropriate to capture in reservoir models.
