Fellows can apply for the professional qualifications of Chartered Geologist (CGeol) and Chartered Scientist (CSci). Both require high standards of knowledge, competence and professionalism and are recognised both in the UK and worldwide.

### In addition:

- Chartered Geologists can join the American Association of Petroleum Geologists (AAPG), the American Institute of Professional Geologists (AIPG) and the Institute of Geologists of Ireland (IGI), using the Society's reciprocal arrangements
- Access to further qualifications such as:
  - **SiLC** (Specialist in Land Condition)
  - **RoGEP** (Register of Ground Engineering Professionals)
  - **CSCS cards** (Construction Skills Certification Scheme)
