This year the conference will be held at the University of Leeds, close to their geothermal project and with a particular focus on campus-scale geothermal projects that are developing across the UK.

As the authoritative technical event for geothermal energy in the UK, this three-day conference welcomes professionals and students from across the sector to present on key themes including:

- Campus-scale geothermal projects
- Local and international case studies and lessons learned
- Subsurface geological and geophysical studies
- Ground source heat pumps
- Underground thermal energy storage

- Deep geothermal heat and power production
- Subsurface research on integrated heating, cooling and storage, including for heat networks
- Geothermal energy for data centres
- Drilling practices and cost reduction
- Policy and regulation, including the subsurface evidence base and planning
- Risk management, seismic hazard assessment, community engagement
- Geothermal brines and critical minerals
