- Series of short talks from industry professionals highlighting application of bespoke analytical techniques to inform land quality management decisions.

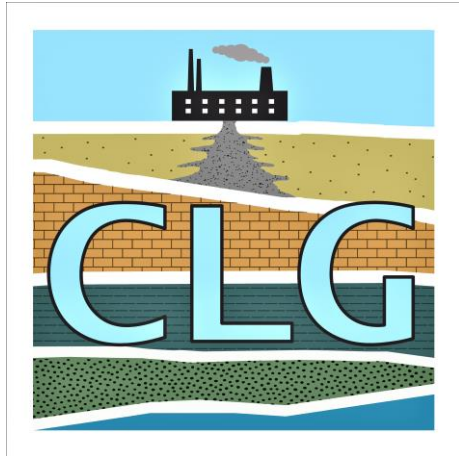
