3) ECN AWARD UPDATE

- RS has compiled list of RGs and competition status.
 - More RGs hosting a competition than previously.
- DH confirmed that secretary of SE regional group confirmed that they held their heat in late 2024.
- Wildcard competition DH
 - Details of hosting
 - Social media and gathering entrants
 - Someone is required to organise the competition.
- Final DH
 - Evening event from 5pm
 - Advertise early April
 - Three judges spread across different industries. To organise as soon as possible.

4) SPONSORSHIP

- Will has put a request into GSL for more funding. Early Careers award costs as much as GSL provides which means other sponsorship required to hold any other events. Need to push on industry funding -DH
- AC mining funding is low at the moment. AC suggests that the ECN goes for a soft touch approach (e.g, We want to do this event, we have this speaker, can we use their office for a talk?). Don't be disheartened.
- ES has asked if ECN has applied to STEM grants. AC and DH have confirmed that in the past the ECN not apply because the ECN do not currently have a bank account external to GSL and therefore would be applying on behalf of GSL.
- DH has indicated that other regional and specialist groups have excess finance and that we should utilise links to e.g. the engineering group so that they can fund the event.

5) SURVEY

- DH Results so far
 - Most people early career professionals (alongside students)
 - Most educated with MSc or above
 - Most interested in workshops and training, followed by fieldtrips.
 - Not much interest in cv/career workshops.
 - Most are fellows but this is not required to be in the ECN.
 - Only 11 responded to regional group response.
 - High response of engineers, therefore could target engineering group for collaborate events.
 - Survey to be left live.
