Retrospective Award of CGeol and Charterships

The Science Council has confirmed that those gaining Chartered Geologist status can be awarded Chartered Scientist status retrospectively up to a period of two years without the need of a further interview.

Procedure for Retrospective CSci applications

- 1. Apply within a 2 year period post award of CGeol.
- 2. Application to consist of the CGeol application along with a completed CSci application form.
- 3. A CPD record for the intervening period post CGeol to be provided along with evidence of M level work (if a Master's degree MSc/MGeol/MSci is not held).
- 4. Criteria i and ii differ for CSci and hence a report is required explaining how these criteria have been fulfilled. If necessary Supporting Documents may be substituted to show this.
- 5. The Application is to be submitted to the Chartership Officer who will decide on eligibility and will then request a review and recommendation from a CSci Scrutineer (or one of the original Scrutineers if they are CSci).
- 6. Accept recommendations will be passed to the Chairman of the Chartership Committee to agree the award through Chairman's action. The decision will then be passed to the Chartership Committee for ratification at their next meeting and then on to Council for election.
- 7. Defer recommendations will be reviewed by two CSci Scrutineers and if upheld the Candidate will be informed and advised on future applications.

Retrospective CGeol
