Chartered Professional Geologists and Scientists are required to maintain their Competency through an appropriate programme of Continuing Professional Development and to keep a record of this.

This record is evidence that you are maintaining your competence and is a reassurance to the public and employers that your work is of the highest standard.

- Courses and Lectures

- Learning whilst working
- Adding to knowledge (writing papers)
- Teaching others
- All does not have to be geology as learning IT skills, Financial skills, Management Skills, Organising conferences etc are all CPD.

What should you do as a Geoscience Professional?

Maintain a record of your learning and experience.

- This includes courses you have done, fieldwork undertaken, specialisms/skills you have developed.
- Do not forget to include the learning of soft skills such as Presentation, Team leadership as well as other skills such as GIS.
- This should continue throughout your career

Continuing to record your professional development.



- When you start work record CPD, both work associated and that which you do voluntarily.
- Record all the projects undertaken and the learning involved.
- Follow an annual Plan-Act-Reflect cycle.
- This record shows commitment to professional competency development. It is very useful for keeping your cv up to date and show to a new employer as you move on.

- Ask the prospective employer about their plans for your development. Have they got an Accredited Training Scheme and will you have a mentor?
- Such schemes are valuable to the company allowing them to attract and retain staff by showing that they are valued.
- Employees gain guidance in development of their professional competencies.

- Companies can charge higher fees for professionally qualified staff.
- Some companies have a requirement for Chartership before promotion.
- Raising the status of the profession.
