EARTH SCIENCE WEEK SCHOOLS EVENT

SUSTAINABLE WATER SUPPLIES FOR COMMUNITIES

Thursday 13 October, 10am-2pm at Burlington House, London

The Geological Society is running a special schools event for Earth Science Week 2016. Geologists from the British Geological Survey will lead a workshop on the challenge of providing sustainable water supplies for communities.

The event will explore how water resources are discovered and the multiple factors influencing responsible water management, from climate change and contamination issues to competing socio-economic needs. We also plan to include opportunities for hands-on demonstrations of hydrogeological equipment.

Groups of around 10 A/AS Level students would be ideal for this event. Studying A Level geology is not a requirement to attend; these issues involve specialists in many different areas working together, and scientists & geographers are equally welcome.
