The talk will briefly overview the importance of William Smith's mapping in the Bath and Bristol area and its huge contribution to Engineering Geology. William Smith's unique geological maps, published over 200 years ago, helped to shape the economic and scientific development of Britain. The modern-day maps of Bath and Bristol will then be used to highlight some local engineering geological considerations.

Adam completed an undergraduate degree and PhD at the University of Bristol between 1991 and 1998. His career has incorporated contracting and consultancy both in the UK and Australia and his greatest area of interest is ground risk management.
