

- Either full day, half day, or multiple module courses
- Modules can be purchased individually or as a full programme
- Designed to suit delegates at any career stage, from a postgraduate student through to a specialist

- The opportunity to ask questions and interact with both the course leader and course peers

- Delegates receive certification for each course attended


