4) FUTURE EVENTS

a) The Committee discussed whether the lecture series should be continued into 2022. While the lecture series has been a success, The Committee decides that the current series should end in December, with a view to renew the series in in the second half of 2022. This will be discussed again in due course.

- b) The Committee agreed that we should continue to host the Early Career Award, the rules outlined by MS, HR, DT and AC have been agreed by the Committee and will be distributed to the regional groups in due course. See attached 'ECN Award Rules 2022.pdf'.
- c) The Committee discussed the idea of returning to in-person events in 2022. However, it was noted by several members that at present the threat of restrictions remains (particularly as we go further into winter) and that virtual events have been positive for attendance and engagement. At this stage the Committee agreed to keep events virtual, and to review this issue again in Spring 2022.
- d) DH proposed 2 ½ day software workshops (preferably in person) with RocScience approx. 20 delegates <£100 each aimed at graduate engineering geologists and geotech engineers at how to interpret and model data. Possible to run an online webinar beforehand/instead outlining what software is available and how it can be used.
