Synopsis:

The presentation will outline the application process with advice on the "do's and dont's" of an application. In particular the role of the Sponsors will be emphasised in ensuring that the application is made when the applicant is "ready" for Chartership and not just as soon as they are eligible to apply.

The new CPD system will be described with discussion as to how it will work using unweighted hours as opposed to the old points system. Information will be available on RoGEP and also information on progress of the Society's move towards offering CEng.

About the Speaker:

Bill previously had a career in academia at Universities of Missouri, Aston and Birmingham. His PhD was in the area of Canadian Pre-Cambrian geology and geochemistry related to exploration for mineral deposits. He is the Chartership Officer of the Geological Society since 2009 and dealt with some 1,000 applications for Chartership.
