

This year, in the northwest, we are hosting a family event to celebrate Earth Science Week, with a short child-friendly plesiosaurs lecture from Dean Lomax, followed by an opportunity to ask loads of questions and also have a look at some real plesiosaurs! Afterwards, we will have an informal trip to the Manchester Museum (The geology galleries are open during the refurbishments!!).

Dean Lomax is a palaeontologist, science communicator and author. He has travelled the globe and worked on many

fascinating projects from excavating dinosaurs in the American West, to describing new species of extinct marine reptiles and winning a gold medal for excellence in science. A visiting scientist at The University of Manchester, Dean is passionate about communicating palaeontology with the public and regularly appears on television, including as series advisor and recurring on-screen expert presenter for ITV's Dinosaur Britain. He has written two books, numerous scientific papers, and many popular articles. Dean is also the patron of the UK Association of Fossil Hunters.
