Getting Here

BY CAR

The main car parks for St Martin's are the Bullring, Edgbaston Street and Moor Street car parks.

Bullring:

Sat Nav: B5 4EG. Entrances are on Smallbrook Queensway and Park Street Please note there is a height restriction of 2.15m. Pedestrian access for the Car Park is available via the St. Martin's Square entrance when the centre is closed. Doors are located next to Pizza Hut, Nando's and the Church. These doors remain open until midnight, 7 days a week.

Edgbaston Street

Sat Nav: B5 4RQ or Pershore Street. Entrances are on Station Street and Pershore Street .Please note that there is a height restriction of 2.15m. Customers travelling to Edgbaston Street are asked to be advised of a new two-way system around nearby Dudley Street which will further aid their journey to and from the car park.

Lost tickets are charged from the time of customer's entry.

BY TRAIN

Birmingham New Street station is located below Grand Central and connected to Bullring. The station is served by Virgin, Cross Country, Arriva Trains Wales and London Midland.

Moor Street station is located on the East Mall side of Bullring (next to Selfridges) and offers local connections with operators such as London Midland and Chiltern Railways.

Snow Hill station is located a 15 minute walk away from Bullring & Grand Central and can also be easily accessed via Midland Metro Tram network.

BY BUS

The main bus stops for local services can be found at the following locations: outside Moor Street Station, Upper Dean Street, Corporation Street, Colmore Row and Bull Street

Centro, the regional transport authority, has an information point outside New Street Station.
