Chartership: Routes and Options

Synopsis:

Accreditation as a Chartered Geologist or Chartered Scientist is a sign to clients, regulators, employers and the general public that you are a competent professional who can demonstrate a high level of knowledge, skills and experience, and that you are bound by a strict code of professional conduct.

The 'Chartered' designation indicates a professional practitioner who has been peer assessed as having key professional competencies and experience in their field of practice. They are required to maintain their professional skills and knowledge through an appropriate programme of Continual Professional Development (CPD) and are bound by an enforceable Code of Conduct.

As part of the talk, Shaun will be discussing the reasons for becoming Chartered, pathways to Chartership, the application process, interview stage and common pitfalls.



About the Speaker:

Shaun Richardson has spent over 35 years as a Petroleum Geologist living and working across the world in a range of Oil and Gas Industries. Over this time he held a number of senior technical and managerial roles. In early 2019 Shaun took up the role of Chartership Officer with The Geological Society and continues to promote both the society and benefits of Chartership. Shaun holds both Chartered Geologist (CGeol) and Chartered Scientist (CSci), along with Certified Professional Geologist (CPG) from the American Institute of Professional Geologists.
