ROCK NETTING SYSTEMS - DESIGN, INSTALLATION AND WHOLE-LIFE MANAGEMENT

**An evening meeting by the Engineering Group
of the Geological Society (EGGS)**



Rock netting systems are used extensively throughout the UK to control rock falls. Such netting systems range from legacy systems to those designed with more rigorous modern standards. The CIRIA C775 guide on Rock netting systems – design, installation and whole-life management is structured to help designers decide on the type of system that would be appropriate and what the considerations are for design, and what should be considered during the lifetime of the asset.

The authors will outline the approaches described in the Guide and highlight the key considerations to be considered by designers and asset managers when deploying rock netting systems.
